

CONFLUENCE CHAPTER PROJECT

LOCATION DIRECTIONS

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BANGERT ISLAND

From I-70 in St. Charles City, go south on Fifth Street/South River Road for approximately one-half mile. Turn left on Old South River Road to the park entrance along the Katy Trail.

BROEMMELSIEK PARK

From Hwy 40/61, go west on Hwy DD for five miles to Schwede Road. Turn right on Schwede Road and follow into the park.

CREVE COEUR PARK (FOREST RELEAF NURSERY)

From I-70 take the Earth City Expressway south, Exit 231A, which turns into Maryland Heights Expressway. From the Maryland Heights Expressway, turn left on the second Creve Coeur Mill Road exit. In approximately 1 mile turn left on the gravel road just after the Hwy 364 overpass. The Forest ReLeaf Nursery will be the first building on the right.

From St. Louis County, take Olive Blvd to Creve Coeur Mill Road. Go approximately 2 miles, passing the Creve Coeur Lake House, and turn right on the gravel road just before the Hwy 364 overpass. The Forest ReLeaf Nursery will be the first building on the right.

DANIEL BOONE HAYS PROJECT IN HAYS-MATSON HILL PARK

From the interchange of Hwy 40/61 and Hwy 94,, go south on Hwy 94 to Hwy F and turn right. Continue on Hwy F to Stub Road and turn left to the Daniel Boone Hays home. Note: this area of the park is not open to the public and there is a locked gate before the bridge over the Femme Osage stream. The gate will be open on project workdays.

FIRST STATE CAPITOL

The FSC is located at 200 S. Main in the City of St. Charles.

HIDEAWAY HARBOR PARK

Take Hwy 94 north to Grafton Ferry Road. Turn north on Grafton Ferry Road to Portage Road. Turn right on Portage Road and drive to Sioux Drive, turn left on Sioux Drive and follow into the park.

INDIAN CAMP CREEK PARK

From I-70, go north on Hwy 61 for approximately seven miles to Dietrich Road. Turn west on Dietrich Road to the park entrance.

KLONDIKE PARK

The park entrance is located on Hwy 94 south, approximately 14 miles south of the Hwy 40/94 interchange, between Defiance and Augusta.

LEWIS & CLARK BOATHOUSE AND NATURE CENTER

From I-70 go north on the 5th Street exit. Turn right on Boone's Lick Road and continue until one block past Main Street where you should veer right crossing the RR tracks, continue through the parking lots and the Boathouse is straight ahead. Park in front of the Boathouse.

Don Robinson State Park: LUM MILLER HOLLOW, LABARQUE CREEK WATERSHED

All mileage is cumulative from the intersection of I-44 and Hwy 109. Go south on Hwy 109 for 2.2 miles, then turn left on Hwy W, at 7.5 miles turn right on Byrnsville Road, at 14.4 miles turn right on Sand Cut Road and then within a few hundred feet turn right on the gravel Don Robinson Road. Continue on the Don Robinson road to the home of Don Robinson where volunteers will meet, as worksites are spread over a large area.

MATSON HILL PARK

From the interchange of Hwy 40/61 and Hwy 94, go south on Hwy 94 to Defiance. Turn right on Matson Hill Road and watch for a park sign on the right.

QUAIL RIDGE PARK

From I-70, exit onto Hwy 40/61 south. At the traffic light, turn right on Callahan Road onto Quail Ridge Parkway. The park entrance is on the left at the end of the parkway.

Going west on Hwy 40/61, take the Prospect exit near Wentzville, turn left and go back over Hwy 40/61 and turn right on Quail Ridge Parkway, which leads to the park on the left at the end of the parkway.

TOWNE PARK

Six miles north of the I-70 on Hwy 61 turn right on Farris Road and then make an immediate right which leads to the park entrance.

YOUTH ACTIVITY PARK

YAP is located at 7801 Hwy N in Dardenne Prairie, between Bryan Road and Hwy 40/61.

WELDON SPRINGS INTERPRETIVE CENTER

Take Hwy 94 south of Hwy 40/61, past Hwy D, the high school, MoDot and the Katy Trail Bridge to the entrance on the right. Drive back to the buildings.
